Objective: To provide support to Doctoral candidates to do an in-depth analysis in the area of "Human-Computer Interaction (HCI), Computer Science, Industrial Design, Cognitive Science, and Multisensory Applications" by applying independent methodologies of scientific research and creating new technology solutions for the industrial application in HCI.

Fellowship Grant: INR 37,500/- per month.

If selected, the applicant cannot avail of any other fellowship in parallel.

Duration: Maximum 24 months.

Eligibility for Fellowship Programme:

Students registered in any unfunded doctoral program can apply for the fellowship with the conditions given below:

- Applicants must be aspiring to work in the areas of "Human-Computer Interaction (HCI), Computer Science, Industrial Design, Cognitive Science, and Multisensory Applications".
- The CGPA of the applicant should be greater than or equal to 7.00 in graduation and post-graduation.
- The nationality of the candidate is not a constraint.

Desirable: Those candidates who qualified for GATE/GPAT, NET, or equivalent examination will be preferred.

Selection Procedure:

- 1. Each candidate needs to submit a proposal that should consist of the details of the project and the candidate, the aim of the project, the gap with the industry, methodology, and expected deliverables and must integrate the expected output to industrial applications as per goal.
- 2. Any idea that has the potential to lead to a technology (start-up) is highly encouraged.
- 3. The proposals will be shortlisted based on the eligibility criteria, feasibility, and originality of the proposal.
- 4. Shortlisted applicants may be asked to present their proposals to the evaluation committee.
- 5. The nationality of the candidate is not a constraint.
